TIPS FOR SPRING MAINTENANCE ON MAUSOLEUMS & COLUMBARIUMS

While granite is durable and mostly maintenance-free, other components that make up the building structure require regular preventive care. When considering the type of maintenance you should do on a cemetery building, use the following eight tips to help you prepare for the changing seasons.

Get up on the roof and conduct an inspection to identify any cracks or gaps.

Clean roofs of all dirt, debris, contaminants and moisture.

Check for water leaks such as dark spots on the walls and floors.

Repair any loose joints with non-bleeding (NB) caulking.

Eliminate blockage that could lead to drainage issues.

Ensure air vents are clear and properly sealed.

Prune branches hanging above your buildings to reduce debris accumulation.

Clear the weep holes on the bottom of bronze doors and windows to prevent trapping in any condensation.
